## Hotels


We recommend that you stay in center city, preferably on what is known as Presqu'île (1st or Northern part of 2nd arrondissement; see map below). This neighborhood, a UNESCO World Heritage site, is very nice and lively. This is also where we will have the gala dinner: Grand Café des Négociants, 1 place Francisque Régaud. Should you prefer to stay near the school, there's a Campanile hotel right across the road. However, we must say that at € 93.00, it's severely overpriced and it would be a pity not to see Lyon.

## Coming to Lyon

## By plane

The airport, "Lyon Saint Exupéry", is about 30 km East of Lyon.

Buses leave the airport every 20 minutes and take you to Lyon for € 8.90. It takes 20 minutes to go to Grange Blanche where you can take the subway (line D straight to Bellecour if you're going to center city; or straight to Gorge de Loup if you're going to the school—more on that later). More information on buses (including timetables) is available from their website.

Taxis for center city would be between € 40 and € 60, depending on time. Taxis for the school would be about € 50 to € 70, according to the airport website.

## By train

Lyon's biggest train station is Lyon-La Part-Dieu, so chances are your train will go there. However, check if it also calls at Lyon-Perrache, which would be more convenient, whether you go to center city or to the school.

Once in a station, you can travel by subway, bus, or taxi. A map of public transportation is available from the <u>TCL website</u>.

## By car

Well, I'm sure you'll manage: <u>Google Maps</u> is your friend. Parking in Lyon is fairly easy because there are many underground parking lots.

# Coming to EMLYON Business School

## By subway & bus

From Lyon, take subway line D heading towards Gare de Vaise and stop at Gorge de Loup. Take the stairs up and go to bus stop No. 3 going to Dardilly. Leave the bus at "Ecully Grandes Ecoles". You can use a single ticket for both subway and bus: it is valid 1 hour and costs € 1.60. It takes about 30 minutes to go from Place Bellecour to the school (a bit more in rush hours).

More information, timetables, routes etc. are available from the TCL website.

## By taxi

It takes about 20 minutes and costs € 20 to go from center city to the school. Note that there is great variance depending on traffic, which can be heavy. Also, there are not that many taxis roaming the streets, so it's always advisable to book one from your hotel front-desk.



## By car

The school is located in Ecully, about 10 km North of Lyon on the highway to Paris.

Whether you come from Lyon (South) or Paris (North), you'll be on highway "A6 / E15".

Leave it at exit No. 35 "Ecully". Make sure you print a map before going, it's quite complicated.
